

MISSION – WHEN IT RAINS IT POURS

Orders have come through for your force to move to a new sector of the battlefield. However during the movement you come under attack and must fight your way to safety. Luckily you receive a transmission regarding reinforcements, all that is required is for you to transmit details of your location. It is up to your troops to set up a location grid for reinforcements to arrive.

Forces Available

Both players have the same number of A.P. to build a company. Both players are the attacker. You can choose to leave any units in Reinforcements (or none), these units do not have to come from the Reinforcements on your army list.

Tactical Positions

See the map.

Primary Objectives

- * Controlling a container: 2 VP
- * Controlling a Drop point: 1 VP

Secondary Objectives

- * Controlling a container: 100 RP

Special Rules

Deployment: When units are activated for the first time they move onto the owning player's board edge and activate as normal.

Reinforcements:

Controlling 1 drop point: When units arrive from Reserves they can only be dropped onto a drop point that is controlled by the owning player (you count as controlling a drop point for the entire turn after you controlled it at the end of a turn). The entire unit is placed within 10cm of the drop point and can't do anything until the next turn when it activates normally.

Controlling 2 or more drop points: When units arrive from Reserves they can be dropped anywhere within line of sight of your highest ranking officer. For this mission Nanogenerators count as drop points.

Cease Fire

The win condition for this mission is the first person to reach (or go over) 20 victory points. If both players go over 20vp at the end of the round then the person with the most points wins, if this is even the game keeps going until there is a difference in victory points or the 6 turn limit has been reached.

In games where one side totally wipes out the opponent's army before the victory conditions are met, work out the final victory points total by using the method given on the Missions Introduction Page.
